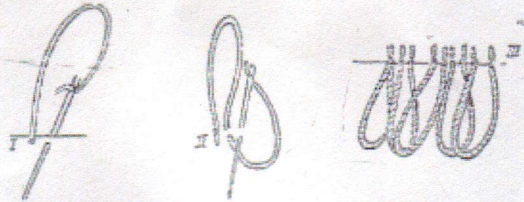


Costume de Peau Rouge 08/02/1923 Indian outfit

Body:

Front and back have the same pattern, all seams are included
 Put the front double fabric, trace and cut
 Put the back at the fold of double fabric, trace and cut out



Collar (only on front side, from shoulder on):

Put on double fabric, trace and cut

Skirt: cut a piece of fabric 30cm x 8cm (12 inch x 3 inch)(add a hem of 2 cm (3/4 inch to make a skirt in stead of a dress)

Sleeves: put at the fold of double fabric, trace and cut

The whole outfit is decorated with fringes, made of wool in lively colours. You also can use raffia
 To make the fringes, follow the instructions shown in the drawings
 Decorate the front, the sleeves, and the hems with glass pearls

In the pattern is no description given to assemble the pieces, I suggest:

- Close shoulder seams of the body
- Gather the upper side of the sleeves, adjust to the armholes; pin and stitch
- Close side seams of body and sleeves
- Hem both centre fronts. Always press the seams very well!
- Hem the sleeves and the neck
- Make loops and add buttons or use press buttons

If you want to make a dress:

- Gather the upper side of the skirt, adjust to the body, pin and stitch
- Close the back seam of the skirt
- Make a hem

If you want to make a skirt:

- hem the body
- Make a tunnel at the upper side of the skirt
- Close the back seam and make a hem
- Pull an elastic through the tunnel, adjust to bleurette's waist

Hem the bottom, shoulder and centre front side of the collar pieces
 Pin and stitch the collar on the body (neck)

- Devant: front
- Col: collar
- Epaule: shoulder
- Manche : sleeve
- Ourllet du bas: bottom hem
- Petite veste: little jacket
- Emmanchure : armhole
- Couture: stich
