

## Costume Boulonnaise 23/01/1930

Here's one of the beautiful regional costumes of France; the Boulonnaise (from Boulogne sur mer). Typical is the 'halo' made of transparent handmade lace

The bodice is made of wool or silk . Put both patterns at double fabric (front at the fold) Hem neck and armholes. The bodice has no sleeves. 4 Galleons red or black with white or red embroidery decorate the bodice.

The shawl covers the arms. It's a square of fabric surrounded by 3 or 4 narrow ribbons  
Fold it double to dress Bleurette

The skirt is made out of light flannel. Take a piece of fabric of 13cm x 35 cm ( 5 1/8" x 13 3/4")

Gather the waist, adjust to the bodice. Pin and stitch. Close the back seam  $\frac{3}{4}$   
Hem the bottom seam. Add snaps

The apron is in black , or lively coloured silk, traced on the fold of double fabric.  
Decorated with some velvet ribbons at the bottom. Cut the waistband at the fold of your double fabric. Stitch the 2 pockets on the apron

Bonnet: the pattern is given on  $\frac{1}{4}$ . Cut out and gather the surrounding . Adjust to Bleuettes head. The halo, made in handmade lace is pleated as shown in the sketch. You need three times the length. Stitch the halo to the bonnet

Give Bleurette white socks and wooden shoes. And don't forget to give her a basket and fish ... in cardboard
